

Briggsy cooking up a storm at KFC

IT'S not often you find someone who loves their job so much they turn up to their shift early and leave late. But not everyone is like Michael (Briggsy) Briggs.

Michael has epilepsy and when he was younger he had a fit which caused part of his brain to shut down.

That has not stopped the friendly 18-year-old from working at Woodridge KFC, with the special job of making the mashed potatoes and gravy.

"I have good workmates," he says as he admits he likes to sing along to the radio when he works.

"They are good to talk to, they are really nice and friendly."

Michael was helped into his position with Job Placement Limited - a free service which helps people with disabilities into the workforce.

Job Placement Limited employment consultant Tri Pham said even though Michael had a disability he was still keen to work.

"He has a disability but he also has ability," he said.

Michael started work at Woodridge KFC in early January and store manager Dee Little said he was doing well.

"He's always coming in early, he still wants to come to work even when he is sick," she said.

"We give people like Briggsy the opportunity because it gives them a chance and gives us extra hands on board."

Michael, who became a client of Mr Pham's when he finished school last year, said he always knew he wanted to work in the food industry.

"At school I did hospitality and I want to be a chef," he said.

Michael usually does four or five four-hour shifts at KFC a week and said he wanted to stay working at the store for "as long as they keep me here".

One person who helps Michael keep his job is Mr Pham who watches over Michael as he works two or three times a week.

"When he first started I was here every shift," Mr Pham said.

"Michael doesn't have a good sense of safety and we

don't want to see anything happen to him.

"The main reason why I am here is to help Michael keep the job."

Mr Pham said Job Placement Limited covered a large area, with the head office in Woodridge.

"Our job is to help people

and support them, and provide on the job training," he said.

"We help them to stay in the job for as long as possible."

Logan turns to Goldy for water

LOGAN will soon have "next to no reliance" on Wivenhoe Dam, according to Logan City Council Governance, Finance and Water committee chairman, Councillor Luke Smith.

From June 30, 20 mega-litres of water a day will be drawn from the Gold Coast, as Logan becomes the next link in the southeast Queensland water grid.

Residents in the suburbs Loganholme, Cornubia, Shailer Park, Daisy Hill, Slacks Creek, Springwood, Underwood, Rochdale South, Kingston, Woodridge, Beenleigh and Eagleby will receive their water from the Gold Coast.

Cr Smith said the new water would be as healthy and safe as the water residents were currently used to.

"There might be a slight difference in taste," he said.

The new supply, equal to 10 Olympic-sized swimming pools, is part of the Queensland Water Commission's program to secure long-term water supplies in the region.

The water grid will provide a network of two-way pipelines to connect major bulk water sources across the region. Cr Smith reminded residents to keep using water wisely as the whole region started to share its water supplies.
